Head to Atlanta's Buckhead neighborhood – known as the Beverly Hills of the South – for the region's best shopping this holiday season. Write a list, check it twice, and don't forget to get something nice for yourself!



1 Phipps Plaza Mall

Shops: 100+

Start your trip at Saks Fifth Avenue and Nordstrom, then make your way to Phipps Plaza's smaller luxury shops, like Tory Burch, Valentino and Versace.

Holiday cheer: Atlanta's most famous Santa for an incredible Christmas card

2 Lenox Square Mall

Shops: 250

With more than 250 specialty shops – ranging from Apple to Athleta, Bloomingdales to Brooks Brothers – Lenox Square Mall pairs both national destination shops and local boutiques.

Holiday cheer: Macy's Pink Pig ride, which has delighted kiddos since the 1950s

3 Shops Around Lenox

Shops: 18

Walk tree-lined promenades and pop into Atlanta's hippest shops, like Tootsies and Suitsupply menswear, right in the heart of Buckhead.

Lunch spot: Seven Lamps for its famous 50/50 burger

4 The Shops at Buckhead Atlanta

Shops: 40

Source international styles at the world's most luxury brands – including Dior, Hermes, Tom Ford and Etro – in this high-end, outdoor shopping destination.

Lunch spot: The Southern Gentleman, a Southern gastropub

5 Atlantic Station

Shops: 50+

Go south for a family-friendly shopping experience – complete with an ice skating rink – in this live, work and play space. Hit the Atlanta Falcons Official Team Store, West Elm and Banana Republic.

Lunch spot: The Pig and the Pearl for seafood and barbeque

Ready to wear those new boots out?

Once you're done shopping, have dinner, see a show, or take advantage of Atlanta's mild winters.

6 The Palm

It's been an Atlanta staple for 90 years – and with good reason – thanks to its classic Italian dishes paired with Southern hospitality.

7 Buckhead Theatre

Open since 1931, the newly renovated Buckhead Theatre showcases sold-out shows of all genres in a Spanish-Baroque art house hall.

8 Atlanta Botanical Garden

Stroll through the Walk of Flames and Tunnel of Light at the garden's annual Garden Lights, Holiday Nights – a favorite of Atlantans and visitors alike.
